Dear Parents/Carers

Year 4 trip to Wroxeter Roman City - Tuesday 22nd October 2024

To deepen your child's understanding of the Roman Empire, the children are going to visit 'Wroxeter Roman City'. The children will explore the unique recreated Roman town house, complete with painted rooms, bath and replica furniture. The children will explore what Britain was like during the Roman Empire and engage in activities such as 'eat like a Roman' and 'mosaic makers'.

We will travel by coach (promptly leaving at **8:30am**) so the children will need to be in school by **8:15am** at the Goldsmith Road gate. We will arrive back to school at **4:00pm** and will also dismiss from our classrooms (arrive at Goldsmith Road gate). You will however be kept up to date via Class dojo should we be delayed due to traffic.

Due to seasonal weather, it is **important** that your child has warm, appropriate clothing:

Your child **must** wear:

- Gloves and a woolly hat
- Warm coat
- Suitable footwear such as trainers as some of the outdoor areas is muddy
- Full school uniform

Please send your child with a packed lunch in a named, disposable plastic bag. If you would like school to provide lunch for your child on trip day could you please consent via the form on Arbor entitled 'Lunch preference for school trips'.

The cost of the trip and the coach will be funded through school support and voluntary payment plan. This is payable on Arbor by a one off payment of £50.00 or by 10 monthly payments of £5.00 from 1st October 2024 (total payable £50.00) no cash payments will be accepted.
