### **Year 6 Trip to Bewdley Museum - Friday 8th November 2024**

Dear Parent/Carer

To bring learning to life for **one of our upcoming History units about World War II, Year 6 will be visiting Bewdley Museum on Friday, 8th November 2024.** This will be a fantastic opportunity for pupils to immerse themselves in many aspects of life during this significant historical event, including a visit to a real air raid shelter.

Children will be travelling by coach to the museum. We will leave school promptly at **9:00 am** to ensure we arrive on time for our session at 10:00 am. Due to some activities, children will need to wear their full school PE kit, along with suitable shoes or trainers and a waterproof jacket. We aim to return to school by **3:00 pm** for the usual dismissal time. Should there be any delays, we will notify you via Class Dojo.

As we will be there for the entire school day, pupils are required to bring a small, healthy snack, which they can have once we arrive at the museum before our session starts. Please also send your child with a packed lunch. If your child is eligible for free school meals and you would like a school-packed lunch, please let us know via the form sent out on Arbor titled 'Lunch Preference for School Trips.'

There is a small gift shop where pupils will have time to visit. We recommend bringing no more than £10 for spending money, and all children will be responsible for any money they bring. Please note that bringing money is optional.

The cost of the trip and the coach will be funded through school support and a voluntary payment plan. This can be paid on Arbor either as a one-off payment of £50.00 or by 10 monthly payments of £5.00 starting 1st October 2024 (total payable: £50.00). No cash payments will be accepted.
