We would like to congratulate our Year 6 pupils on their amazing SATS results,

achieving the below, outstanding pass rates. We are so proud of you all!

Reading: 86% EXP+ and 43% at Greater Depth

Maths: 79% EXP+ and 9% at Greater Depth

Writing: 76% EXP+ and 5% at Greater Depth

Reading, Writing and Maths Combined: 74% EXP+ and 3% at Greater Depth The Combined National Average was 59%.

WAT's combined attainment in Reading, Writing and Mathematics is 67%. This is 8% above the national average and a superb achievement!


A polite reminder to those of you who pay for school meals, ParentMail accounts need to be credited in advance of children receiving a meal, to prevent any outstanding balances arising.
