In addition, choose one of these activities to follow up your reading each day:


- Write a short review detailing your likes and dislikes about the novel so far. You need to explain/ justify your opinion with examples from the text.

- **Research:** Research how and why tsunamis occur. What damage can they cause? Use this research to create fact files or PowerPoints. Be as creative as you can.
